**Public comment/concern from those present:**

Ed Mulkearn – Mr. Mulkearn spoke regarding the point of “anything not in the zoning law was not allowed.” He stated he has spoken with a Pennsylvania attorney who said it could be “spot” zoned so the public wouldn’t have to wait until the zoning was completely redone. Supervisor Brumagin explained the process of the Board having the right to enact a new law or amendment to the law and the steps to accomplish this;

Ryan Pratt spoke to the Hazen Road speed limit matter. He stated he walks on the road a lot and the cars cannot drive fast as the road does not allow for vehicles to travel at a high rate of speed. Joe Kelwaski stated you could not stay on the road if you drove 55 MPH. His opinion was the top speed you could drive would be 45 MPH;

Larry Meeder questioned the cost of a permit and any refund he may have. Supervisor Brumagin stated she will address this issue with Melanie Eddy and Supervisor Brumagin will call him on Friday of this week pending a snow storm. He also questioned if two (2) different farms had been issued building permits for the barns that have been built. Supervisor Brumagin said she will have the Code Enforcement Officer look into this;

Joe Kelwaski asked about small sheds. Supervisor Brumagin said he would have to speak with the Code Enforcement Officer in order to get the correct information. Councilman Bensink also reminded Supervisor Brumagin of the building on the dock. Supervisor Brumagin will discuss this with Melanie Eddy as well.

**Public Comments from those not present:**

a. Christmas Decorations – Dave Calvert asked at the Saturday Public Hearing about the Town having Christmas decorations. Discussion was held regarding the decorations which used to be put up. Supervisor Cooper will check with Superintendent Scarem.

b. Pickle ball – Supervisor Brumagin has been contacted by Bill Deuink who has offered to teach the community members how to play pickle ball in the gym or on the tennis courts. Councilman Wilcox will contact the Recreation Committee.

**Old Business:**

▪ Zoning – Supervisor Brumagin handed out copies of letters and information she has received. The Board will look at this in more detail at the year end meeting.
