Town of Mina Proposed Findley Lake Sewer District Grants for Low Income Qualified Households October 16, 2023

Hookup and Septic Decommissioning Grants for Low Income Individuals:

If the proposed district passes, CHRIC (Chautauqua Home Rehabilitation & Improvement Corporation) will work with the Town of Mina to apply for NYS Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) monies that will fully cover the cost of hooking up to the new sewer system and decommissioning the septic system for low income qualified households. The grant, if received, covers 100% of the cost for a primary residence following federal guidelines. For example, the 2023 maximum income eligibility guidelines are as follows:

Additionally, the Findley Lake Community Foundation Board of Directors has committed to establishing a fund of \$100,000 to assist with hooking up to the new sewer system and decommissioning the existing septic system following similar guidelines to the CDBG grant and other grant requirements.
